### WHAT THE SYSTEM PRODUCES

Exit Protocol is a user-triggered forensic intelligence platform. It accepts only explicitly selected financial documents from a matter. The workflow requires ledger reconciliation before any calculation begins. Once reconciled, it applies deterministic LIBR tracing using the Lowest Intermediate Balance Rule (See v. See, 1966).

#### THE DELIVERABLE

**A hashed, attorney-reviewable workpaper designed for counsel to evaluate directly. Every step is logged and reproducible so that counsel or a retained forensic professional can verify, challenge, or extend the analysis.**

### CONTROLLED DOCUMENT PATH

The workpaper can be returned to the same matter after local generation in the demonstrated workflow. All source documents remain untouched.

#### **Traceable workpaper. Human legal judgment.**

Counsel evaluates and decides how, or whether, the workpaper is used.

### INCLUDED IN THE WORKPAPER

- Complete transaction ledger with running traceable balances
- Source document identity and SHA-256 hash
- Explicit assumptions and chosen tracing strategy
- Reconciliation result and methodology references
- Cryptographic integrity references for the generated artifact

### WHAT STILL REQUIRES COUNSEL REVIEW

- Legal characterization of the source funds
- Jurisdiction-specific rules and presumptions
- Admissibility decisions
- Litigation strategy, negotiation positioning, or impeachment use
- Final expert opinion or court submission
